LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS

Kevin H. discussed the Governor's deficit reduction plan. The state is currently projected to have a \$500 million deficit. Pharmacy was spared for the most part in the plan but it was vetoed. Another meeting is set with Evelyn Dudley, DSS Pharmacy Manager, on Jan 12th at 10am. L. Sobel suggested forming a LTC operations & consultant pharmacists subcommittee to meet regularly to discuss issues affecting LTC pharmacy. S. Jeffery discussed how Senator Chuck Grassley (R, Iowa) has sent ASCP Executive Director John Feather a letter requesting a complete accounting of all PHARMA funding to ASCP going back to 2006.

SENIOR SYMPOSIUM - Senior Symposium 2010 (SS10) April 8th & 9th

Jeffery reported the CT ASCP Student Chapter and the URI ASCP Student Chapter want to work together at SS10 for networking purposes. In order to have longer exhibit hours M.
