LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS

J. Cannarella stated the Dept of Developmental Services (DDS) is convinced that drugs must be flushed because this is what the current regulation mandates. K. Hill will be meeting with DCP & DPH over the drug destruction issue. CPA is promoting recycling of non-controlled medications via a central repository. The epilepsy bill will lead to dispensing of brand-name-only even when drug is used for behavior control rather than epilepsy. J. Cannarella was contacted by Commissioner of Public Health Bob Galvin regarding getting help with a study on the use of antipsychotics in LTC. John asked any interested volunteers to contact him directly.
